Peat dried malted barley brings strong peatiness, which, however, does not fully mask the delicate fruity aromas. The perfect balance of fruitiness and smoky peat.

Roducer. The Glen Moray distillery is situated in Elgin, the largest town in Speyside. Despite the distillery being established in 1897, the current master distiller, Graham Coull, is only the fifth person to hold that position. Glen Moray distillery currently has over 250,000 barrels of malt whisky maturing. It is owned by the La Martiniquaise Group. La Martiniquaise is a private family-owned company. Jean Cayard founded La Martiniquaise in 1934, and it remains under the ownership of the Cayard family. The group is the second-largest alcohol company in France.

COLOR Light golden yellow

AROMA With smokey turf on the first nose, with vanilla and rhubarb aromas in the background

TASTE Medium, warm. The first aromatic world offers smoke and peat, which soon folds into spiciness and then vanilla fruitiness. Long expressive aftertaste
