"Collector's item"

Story Collector's item, Single Cask. Distilled in 1999, aged more than ten years. Best single cask 2021 (International sugar cane competition). A rum rarity, the rum lover's favourite, Agricole rum. Agricole rum is made from sugarcane juice, which produces rich and strong rums compared to conventional rums, which are made from syrup or molasses extracted from sugar cane juice. The rum is from Martinique in the Lesser Antilles of the West Indies, in the eastern Caribbean Sea.

roducer Saint James was acquired by the French La Martiniquaise Group in 2003, but the premium Caribbean Saint James rums have been produced since 1765. Saint James AOC Martinique Agricole rums are distilled from freshly pressed sugar cane juice. Saint James is the world's most famous producer of Agricole rums, and these rums are particularly popular in France and its territories. However, Saint James Reserve is not an Agricole rum, as it is produced with a broader international audience in mind. It is a blend of distillates from six different Caribbean islands. The distillates are aged in oak barrels on their respective islands for at least 24 months before blending. Each island imparts its unique character to the rum: Guyana for balance, Jamaica for strength and banana aromas, Guadeloupe for vanilla and tropical fruits, Martinique for dried fruits and oak aromas, Trinidad for light fruit aromas, and Barbados for elegance and freshness.

COLOR Dark mahogany brown

AROMA Sweet roasted coffee and chocolate aroma, nutmeg and notes of heather. Dried fruit with spiciness on the nose. A fresh aroma of ginger emerges on the nose towards the finish.

TASTE Tree and nutmeg aromas, moccha and dried fruit. Long and wellbalanced aftertaste
