AROMA The scent is reminiscent of citrus fruits, green apple, ripe honeydew melon, yellow grapefruit and minerals

TASTE Dry, freshly acidic, notes of citrus, yellow plum, grapefruit and mineral notes. The wine has a good texture, a rich taste and the slight amount of residual sugar is not felt due to the acids, but gives the wine a boost

TIPS FOR USE A versatile food wine, but at its best with seafood delicacies, fish and poultry. Soft cheeses are also an excellent match. Perfect also with spicy Asian dishes.
