MOULIN À VENT CHÂTEAU DES JACQUES CLOS DU GRAND CARQUELIN

Producer "Château des Jacques stands as one of the most renowned and respected producers in the Beaujolais region. They craft their wines in the same Burgundian style and methods as were used in the area centuries ago, much like the renowned Pinot Noirs from the top vineyards in the northern Cote d'Or region. Grapes are handpicked in whole clusters with stems removed. Only wild yeasts are used in the winemaking process. The majority of the estate's wine production is uncertified organic, while they partially adhere to biodynamic farming practices. The choice of uncertified organic is due to the estate's flexibility, allowing them to adapt to the vastly varying conditions in the region. Château des Jacques wines are exceptionally long-lived, capable of aging for several decades, which is rare in the region. The estate has been under the ownership of Louis Jadot since 1996. Louis Jadot was the first Burgundy house to invest in the Beaujolais region and acquire vineyards there."
