Baron de Ley created the Varietals range to honour the traditional grape varieties of the Rioja region. As a variety, Graciano has traditionally been used in Rioja blends. Thanks to its good acidity and tannins, Graciano gives the blends freshness and longevity. The Baron de Ley Varietal Graciano is made from hand-picked Graciano grapes from the Rioja Baja region. The wine has matured in American oak casks for twelve months.

Roducer Bodegas Barón de Ley is a respected Spanish wine producer with over 1000 hectares of vineyards in the Rioja regions of Cenicero, Mendavia, Ausejo, and Carboneras. The headquarters of Barón de Ley is located in Mendavia, within a magnificent building complex constructed in 1548 by the Count of Equía as his fortress and stronghold. Over the years, the estate transformed from a Benedictine monastery where monks raised sheep and produced wine under their command until 1836. Subsequently, the estate had several powerful owners. After various stages, the property returned to the ownership of Barón de Ley's founders in the 1980s.
