

Italy. Amarone della Valpolicella, Veneto | 2021

CASTEL MARE AMARONE CLASSICO

Story This wine comes from the Veneto region in northeastern Italy. Amarones are made from dried grapes. In this so-called appassimento method, harvested grape bunches are allowed to dry in a cool environment for a few months before the wine is made. During drying, a third or even half of the weight of the grapes evaporates and their sugar content increases, the acidity decreases and the taste and aroma are concentrated. The method produces extremely full-bodied, wines with higher alcohol content and some residual sugar. Amarones are made from fully dried grapes.

Producer Mare Magnum's company philosophy is clear: there are many expensive high-quality wines in the world, but the greatest demand actually lies in high-quality wines that come with a reasonable price. Experienced individuals, Takis Soldatos and Mario Calzolari, founded Mare Magnum to produce wines that cater specifically to this demand. The company's production started with Italian wines originating from Apulia, Abruzzo, Piedmont, Sicily, Tuscany, Umbria, and Veneto. Mare Magnum's international team of winemakers continually travels the world, and their collaboration has resulted in many charming, modern wines from quite diverse locations. Currently, these include Australia, Spain, South Africa, South America, California, Greece, France, and New Zealand. Regardless of the country or wine, Mare Magnum's primary goal is to offer consumers exceptionally good value for money in innovative and attractive packaging.

COLOR Dark ruby red colour with a hint of blue

AROMA Cherries, sour cherries, raisins, dark plums, currants, leather, chocolate, vanilla and spices

TASTE Very generous, silky tannins, sour cherry notes, leather notes, figlike and spicy. An elegant, well-balanced representative of its type

TIPS FOR USE Stylish, classic pure wine, which is ideal for quality and heavy meat dishes. A good choice for ripe cheese. Suitable as a meditation wine and can be used as a substitute for port wine during the Christmas season. We recommend decanting this wine.
