

oducer Founded in 1856, Cousiño-Macul is the oldest winery in Chile and is known as one of the country's finest wine producers. The estate focuses primarily on high quality in its production. All of their wines are made exclusively from their own grapes, following an authentic Chilean style. Located near Santiago, southeast of the city, in the Maipo Valley at the foot of the Andes, the vineyards are well protected from frost. The soil varies significantly. The estate cultivates nine grape varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, and Riesling. The first vine cuttings were imported from France in the 1860s. Cousiño-Macul operates based on principles of sustainable development and minimal intervention. Chemical use is kept to a minimum. Still family-owned, each generation of Cousiño-Macul aims to leave its own legacy by continuously improving upon their practices, if possible.



AROMA on the nose, there is butter, cream, vanilla, ripe apples, orange peel and honey

TASTE Dry, soft acidic, creamy, notes of apple, pineapple and lightly spicy. The mouthfeel is chewably rich, the wine has good texture and a long, fruity aftertaste

TIPS FOR USE Suitable as a tasty aperitif and by the glass even when preparing food. Pairs well with fish and shellfish, grilled poultry, for salads and emmental cheese.
