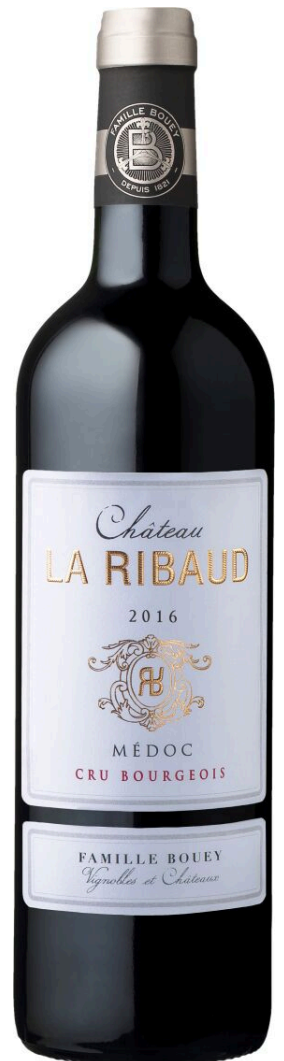
Château La Ribaud is named after its location in the village of Saint-Yzens-de-Médoc. Managed for generations by passionate winegrowers, the estate was acquired by Patrick Bouey in 2015. The wine is primarily a blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon, with small amounts of Cabernet Franc (5%) and Malbec (1%). This blend gives the wine a round, rich structure and excellent aging potential. The grapes are mainly sourced from vineyards in the Saint-Yzens-de-Médoc area, and the winemaking process has been carried out in collaboration with the talented and award-winning winemaker Stéphane Derenoncourt. Château La Ribaud 2016 has received several awards in wine competitions and was rated 91 points by James Suckling.

COLOR Garnet red

AROMA Aromas of redcurrant, dark forest berries, with hints of cinnamon and herbal notes.

TASTE Medium-bodied with a fresh mouthfeel. The tannin structure supports the dark fruit flavors beautifully, and the finish reveals a touch of herbal character.

TIPS FOR USE A versatile food wine, excellent with meat dishes, stews, aged hard cheeses, or richly flavored vegetarian dishes such as mushrooms or roasted root vegetables.
