"Tuscany in the style of Suvereto"

Story The name Hebo comes from the history of Suvereto, Etruscan settlement. This means that the wine-growing heritage in the area are ancient. Wine goes in steel tanks with natural yeast. Aging of the year in Slavonian oak casks, then another six months of bottle maturation.

Producer "Terra Moretti is a family-owned business with three main areas of operation: construction, wines, and luxury hotels. In 1977, Vittorio Moretti built his home and vineyard on the hilltop named Bellavista, where he began producing top-quality Franciacorta, which soon gained fame. Subsequently, he established another Franciacorta estate and expanded the wine business to Tuscany. Bellavista spans 198 hectares of vineyards covering 67 different types of soil, representing six distinct landscape types in the Franciacorta region. Their 107 vineyards are divided into 147 plots, which further form 224 micro-plots. Around 60% of their base wines ferment in stainless steel tanks (for fruitiness and acidity), while 40% age in old oak barrels (for depth and complexity). As a result, during spring when the cuvées (blends) are crafted, winemaker Mattia Vezzola has access to approximately 120 to 160 different base wines."

COLOR Ruby red

AROMA Blackcurrant on the nose, black cherries, violets, blueberries, pencils, leather and spices

TASTE Full-bodied, silky tannins, dark notes of berry, dark plum, figlike, moccha and spicy. Quality wine is distinguished by its structure, with its nuance and diversity

TIPS FOR USE A quality glass for Italy's longing. It is an elegant meat wine, especially for mutton and game. Excellent cheese wine immediately reminds us of Taleggio, Pecorino and Gorgonzola Dolce.
