**"Trentino style"**

**Story** Rotari Gran Rosé Brut is made from hand-picked Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes. Pinot Noir grapes come from slopes with varied microclimate and soil, which gives the wines structure and rich aromaticity. Chardonnay of the Adige Valley gets fine acidity and elegant aroma on the high slopes. The alcoholic fermentation of the wine is done in steel tanks to preserve the fruitiness and the Chardonnay undergoes malolactic fermentation. Gran Rosé is made with traditional bottle fermentation and matures with its yeast lees over a period of at least 36 months.

**Producer** The name of these sparkling wines, produced using the traditional bottle fermentation method, is a tribute to King Rotari, who ruled northern Italy in the 6th century and engaged in several battles in the Trentino region. The Lombards were a Germanic tribe, previously believed to have originated from Southern Scandinavia. Rotari sparkling wines, belonging to the Gruppo Mezzacorona, are among the most elegant traditional method sparkling wines in Italy. These wines hail from the heart of the Italian Alps in the Trentino region. The area presents an ideal setting with steep Alpine slopes, green valleys, forests, Alpine lakes and rivers, and cooling winds from the mountains, creating perfect conditions for the crafting of these stylish, elegant, and sophisticated sparkling wines. Chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes are cultivated in terraced vineyards on steep slopes ranging from 290 to 750 meters in altitude. All grapes used in Rotari sparkling wines are meticulously selected and hand-harvested.

**COLOR** Salmon red colour with a hint of pink

**AROMA** Lightly baked raspberries on the nose, with strawberries, red currants, citrus and minerals

**TASTE** Extra dry, freshly acidic, with elegant notes of berries, ripe citrus – a nuanced choice. Quality elegant sparkling wine in classic style

**TIPS FOR USE** A delicious aperitif, a stylish toasting wine, tastes great with savoury snacks and appetisers, but it is also a full-blooded food wine, e.g., for shellfish, fatty fish and white meat.
