An elegant white wine made from 100% Greco grapes grown in the mineral-rich tufo soils of Irpinia. The wine is fresh and structured, with a fruity and subtly mineral aroma profile that reflects the classic character of Greco di Tufo. Only the best grapes are selected for this wine, all harvested by hand in the Santa Paolina area of the Avellino municipality in Campania, Southern Italy. The wine is fermented in stainless steel and then aged on the lees for about a year. This maturation adds richness and a creamy mouthfeel.

COLOR

Light straw yellow

AROMA

A multi-layered aroma with ripe fruit such as peach, pineapple, and apricot, complemented by gentle cedar notes in the background.

TASTE

The generous palate offers fruitiness, freshness, and acidity in perfect balance. The wine is dry, with a long and mineral-driven finish.

TIPS FOR USE

The perfect companion to raw seafood. Its rich flavour profile also pairs beautifully with dishes such as mushroom pasta or herb-infused cheeses.
