# DONNACHIARA TAURASI

““The Barolo of Southern Italy.””

## Story

Perhaps the best-known red wine style of Southern Italy, often compared to Piedmont's Barolo for its elegance and longevity. Made from 100% Aglianico, Taurasi is one of the wines awarded Italy's highest quality classification, DOCG. Vines grown in the clay-limestone soils of Irpinia produce grapes with deep, mineral-driven aromas. The grapes are hand-harvested in early October. The wine undergoes fermentation in stainless steel before being transferred to barrique barrels for maturation.

**COLOR** Intense ruby red

**AROMA** Aromas of ripe red berries, spice, and hints of toasted oak.

**TASTE** A full-bodied wine with firm yet elegant tannins, red berry fruit, and spicy notes. A vibrant, structured acidity.

**TIPS FOR USE** An excellent choice with meat dishes, strong cheeses, or quiet, contemplative enjoyment.
