**Producer** "Global Wine House collaborated with the over century-old Castellani wine estate in Pontedera to create the Cantine Casa Charlize brand. Leveraging their experience and expertise, they have tailored a wine that is hard to resist. From grape harvesting to bottling, the goal is to produce high-quality wine at a reasonable price, a universal ticket to Tuscany. Similar to the top-tier Supertuscan wines that incorporate French grape varieties, the official quality designation given by the authorities is IGT, which stands for Indicazione Geografica Tipica, indicating a typical wine of the region, rather than higher classification levels. The purpose of the Casa Charlize wine range is to combine the quality and reputation of Italian classic wines with a deep appreciation for the history and traditions of winemaking."

**COLOR** Dark ruby red

**AROMA** Sweet cherry jam, boysenberry, blackcurrant, cinnamon, leather and dark chocolate

**TASTE** jam-fruity, dark notes of berry, velvety tannins, with acidic currant notes, long and spicy. Rich and plentiful, easily approachable, tasty and gentle
