This Côtes du Rhône Villages wine is made from Grenache and Syrah grapes grown in the heart of the Papes enclave, in Valréas. The unique geographical location offers exceptional climate conditions that give this wine its structure, complexity, and remarkable freshness. Traditional vinification brings depth and color, with a 30-day maceration and 6 months of aging in French oak barrels.

**COLOR** Ruby red

**AROMA** An elegantly layered bouquet of dark red fruits, marzipan, spices, herbs, and cocoa.

**TASTE** Full-bodied, juicy acidity, silky tannins, hints of strawberry jam, chocolate, spices, and a long finish.

**TIPS FOR USE** Ascaïr Rouge is a refined companion to red meat and boldly flavored sauces. It's especially perfect with roasted duck breast. Thanks to its vibrant acidity, it also pairs beautifully with cheese.
