**Story** "The producer indicates on the label marked as 2.0 that with this wine, they have reached a higher level, and no compromise is acceptable in crafting this unique wine. Only the best, hand-picked grapes were selected for the wine. The exceptionally high alcohol content of 15.5% attests to a good vintage and ripe grapes, yet the acidity remains impressively elegant. After maceration and fermentation on the skins, the wine matured for 18 months in 500-liter new oak barrels. Unique and unparalleled, this high-quality wine has been awarded multiple times. Suitable for vegans.

**Producer** Weingut Braun was established in Meckenheim when the family businesses of the current owners' grandparents merged in the 1970s. The Ellerstadt and Meckenheim estates did not need to ponder a combined name, as both parties bore the surname Braun, despite not being related. The foundational values of Weingut Braun in winemaking revolve around the perspective of nature and respect for the environment, essential elements in producing both everyday wines and distinctive premium wines. "It is a joy to make wine that you fully stand behind but also love to enjoy yourself. We live for and through wine." The wine selection at Weingut Braun is impressively extensive. In addition to Rheinpfalz white wines, the range includes red wines, rosés, and sparkling wines, featuring familiar varieties like Riesling and Müller-Thurgau alongside several lesser-cultivated grapes in the region, such as Cabernet Sauvignon and Sankt Laurent.

**COLOR** Clear ruby red color

**AROMA** In the warm berry-scented aroma, you can feel sour cherries, blackcurrants, cranberries, cinnamon, caramel, and vanilla.

**TASTE** The taste is lush with berries, dense with tannins, elegantly acidic, multifaceted, robust, and stylish. The long finish bends towards spiciness, and although the abundant tannins are almost chewable, they are gentle and ripe.

**TIPS FOR USE** Braun's wine is clearly a food wine, pairing well with many meat dishes from steaks to cutlets. Roasted vegetables also complement this wine. Its fine acidic structure and tannins make it an irresistible cheese wine that is not afraid of anything.
